Pupil Premium

Background

The Pupil Premium is allocated to children from low-income families who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM), this also includes pupils eligible for FSM at any point in the last six years (known as the Ever 6 FSM measure). Schools are free to spend the Pupil Premium as they see fit. However we are held accountable for how we have used the funding to support pupils and we are required to publish the information online.

In April 2014 we had 7 children eligible for Pupil Premium funding, including Service families, and received a total of £6,615 for the financial year. 5 of these children were in year 2. Pupil Premium funding, along with other funding, was used to support children in their academic and personal development. Through:

- Daily in class teaching support
- ELSA support (Emotional Literacy Support Assistant)
- A daily lunch club
- Support with transition

The impact of this spending is summarised below:

- **60-80% of children achieved Level 2B+ in**
- **86% of children had attendance of above 95%**
- **60% of children achieved Level 2B+ in reading**
- **60% of children achieved Level 2B+ in writing**
- **80% of children achieved Level 2B+ in maths**
- **Children were able to access support for their emotional health and well-being making them ore self-aware and confident**

Pupil premium 2015-2016

In April 2015 we received Pupil Premium Funding for those eligible, including Service families, and received a total of £7,200 for the financial year. This is again being used to support children in their academic and personal development and intervention will be tailored to suit the needs of the children.
