

UNIFORM

It is important that your child feels part of the school community and wears clothes suitable for the work he/she is doing, so your child will require the following:-

Plain white blouse / shirt or white polo shirt (Not T-shirt)

Grey skirt/pinafore dress/ grey trousers or grey shorts

Maroon school sweatshirt or cardigan

Black outdoor shoes (no trainers, no open toed sandals)

Red striped/checked gingham dress or culottes (summer)

Grey tights, white, black or grey socks

Please note that the fleeces are outdoor wear only, not to be worn indoors instead of a sweatshirt or cardigan.

PE Kit - in a named PE bag - (PE Kits will need to be kept in school all week)

- Dark plain coloured shorts (Navy or Black)
- Jogging bottoms or leggings (Navy or Black)
- School PE t-shirt or plain white t-shirt,
- Trainers.

A pair of Wellingtons to leave at school

Caps / Hats

In the summer term the children should have a hat or cap to protect them from the sun

Jewellery

Jewellery should not be worn at any time, but if ears are pierced small studs are allowed.

Please note that earrings may not be worn during PE, games or swimming. Teachers are not allowed to take out or replace children's earrings if they are unable to do so themselves. Therefore, it would be helpful if earrings could be taken out on PE days.

Hairstyles: - We believe that hairstyles should be in keeping with our uniform. Children's hair should not be gelled, dyed, spiked nor have lines and patterns shaved into it. Long hair should be tied back.

The school sweatshirts / cardigans, PE t-shirts and bookbags can be purchased from the school office.

In the summer months a swimming costume, swimming hat (for all boys and girls) and large towel will be required.

OVERALLS/APRONS -

A long-sleeved overall or preferably a waterproof apron for art/craft work
