<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Revisiting key mathematical symbols including + - = as well as less than (<) and more than (>)● Exploring addition and subtraction to 20 both using part/whole models, completing number sentences and solving word problems both practically and written.● Place value to 50, using concrete resources to reinforce this● Measuring length and height● Measuring weight and volume● Continuing to work on our 'reasoning' skills by being able to explain how we found our answer	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Reading and spelling set 1,2 and 3 words using Read Write Inc.● Spelling words from the Year 1 common exception word list.● Being independent in writing simple sentences using spaces between words.● Punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop or question mark.● Joining words and joining clauses using and, but and so.● Beginning to correctly use capital letters for names of people, places, days of the week and months of the year● Adding suffixes 's' and 'es' for plurals.
