Maths	English
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Revisiting addition and subtraction to 20, including consolidating our learning on the addition, subtraction and equals signs• Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s with confidence• Using the above to start to explore multiplication as repeated addition• Investigating division as sharing equally as well as making equal groups• Exploring fractions of shapes, objects and amounts• Extending our place value knowledge by moving on to numbers up to 100, representing these with practical resources, pictures and numbers• Exploring position and direction• Recognising coins and notes and counting with coins within 20p• Using the language of time (days and months) and telling the time to the hour and half hour	<p>We will be focusing on writing for various purposes using features of different forms such as stories, and instructions. We will be looking at poetry e.g. Rumble in the Jungle, non-fiction texts, e.g. information books about rainforest animals and fiction books, e.g. Amazon adventure.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Consolidating our learning of set 1,2 and 3 words using Read Write Inc. and using this in our reading and writing• Continuing to learn words from the Year 1 common exception word list – both reading and spelling• Being independent in writing simple sentences using spaces between words, a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark• Extending our sentences by joining clauses using and, but and so.• Use capital letters for names of people, places, days of the week and months of the year• Adding suffixes 's' and 'es' for plurals and introducing the prefix 'un' <p>Note: special friends - a digraph is 2 letters that make one sound; a trigraph is 3 letters that makes one sound; chatty friends (split digraph) e.g. a-e, make</p>
