Year 1 other information

- Children will need to arrive at 8:50am at the Foxes classroom door. School finishes at 3:10. We are aware that some parents are picking up from other schools and require a prompt dismissal so are happy to see these children out slightly early, please try and be near the front of the line if this applies to you.
- Please remember to bring bookbags in each day as they will need to change their reading books and You Read to Me books as well as hand in and take-home homework.
- Homework in Year one consists of one piece of English and one piece of Maths. Occasionally there will be another task to complete, for example a Science of Art task. The children have two weeks to complete their homework and the first homework will be set the week commencing 19th September. Children will come home with a homework book and homework needs to be handed in in this book and will be replaced with the new homework.
- Children need to provide their own pencil case which contains: pencils, a ruler, a glue stick and colouring pencils. Please keep the size of the pencil case to a minimum, no larger than 30cm by 10cm as otherwise it makes it difficult to store them all!
- Our PE days will be a Wednesday and Friday. The children need to come to school in their PE kit on these days. Children should wear black joggers or shorts and trainers with either their Newdigate PE top or their polo and jumper. Fridays will be our 'Feel Good Friday' and will involve a rotation of Yoga, Additional RE and well-being lessons and MOLES. Therefore, children should bring wellies and they can bring additional clothing to prevent their PE kit becoming muddy. Our MOLE days will be on 30th September and 7th and 14th October.
