It will sit alongside our June SIAMS report as an external validation of all that we do and achieve in our wonderful school with your wonderful children. You will have received an a-mail about our issues with Marvellous Me notifications. Messages are being received, but without the usual notification. Open Morning

We are holding an **open morning** on **Wednesday 1**st **November at 9.30 a.m**., starting with a talk from the leaders of the school and then a tour, but we are also happy to arrange individual tours to those who want to see the school on another day.

Water Aid

We will be holding an art exhibition after school on Tuesday 31st October to showcase artwork from all the children based on the theme of water. You will be able to view all the artwork and purchase your child's piece of art for collection at the end of the week. Money raised will be donated to Water Aid, a charity that are working with our federation to raise awareness of their work and the issues they help support. We have been inspired by Olivia Bassage, one of our Year 2 leaders, who decided she wanted to take action after watching a report about some families who did not have easy access to clean safe water. Olivia is a passionate artist and makes lots of pieces at home with her Dad. She will also be selling some of those at the exhibition as a way of raising more money for the charity. Along with her Mum, she will be framing the artwork and getting it ready for display over the half-term. We are very excited to help Olivia support this worthy cause. Jez Heath, a representative from Water Aid, will be visiting the school on 15th November to talk to us and collect the donation.

We had a great turn-out and raised a very respectable £155.95 that we have donated to this worthy charity.



We have been asked by NHS England to share this following information with all our parents:

Over 102,000 children starting primary school in England are at risk of catching measles

With millions of children across the country going back to school this week, NHS England is urging parents to check that their children are up to date with their MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) vaccinations in the wake of measles cases rising across the country.

Childhood vaccination rates have fallen over the past ten years and this week statistics show that over 102,000 children aged four and five years old starting

in reception are not protected against catching measles, mumps and rubella. Measles is highly infectious and if left unvaccinated nine out of ten children in a classroom can catch the disease if just one child is infectious.

If you are unsure if you or your child are up to date, check your child's red book or GP records and make an appointment to catch up any missed doses. For more information on the NHS vaccination schedule, please visit.


